

Lesson Checklist

- Title (that relates to the whole lesson)
- Your name is under the title
- Materials list is under your name
- 3 spell words per chunk (in the color green)
- Minimum of 2 known questions per chunk (in the color green)
- Semi-open questions (in the color orange)
- Math/Number questions (in the color purple)
- Prior Knowledge questions (in the color blue)
- Open ended questions (in the color pink)
- VAKTivity (in the color red and label it VAKTivity)
- Creative writing question at the end of your lesson (in the color pink)
- 5-7 key words per chunk (capitalized in the chunk)
- Define words that may be challenging and put the definition of the word in parentheses next to that word
- Font is Arial, the font color is black (for chunks), and font size is 14
- Line spacing is set as 1 (or single spaced)
- Make sure questions are in color order
- List your references at the end of the lesson
- Make sure known, semi-open, and math questions are answered in CAPS (in the color black font)

Known: A question with only 1 answer. This comes straight from the chunk.

Semi-Open: Has more than one answer but it's not infinite. This comes straight from the chunk.

Prior Knowledge: Something you did not teach, but assume they know.

Math/Number: If you are doing a math question, make sure to show work and give the answer.

Open Ended: Should be answerable in 1-2 sentences

Creative Writing - at the end of the lesson: Infinite amounts of answers.

VAKTivity: An activity related to the lesson (YouTube video, pictures, arts and crafts, exercise, experiments, games, etc.)

Key Words:

- In all caps
- Names of people and places

- Numbers and dates
- New Vocabulary
- Main idea words
- Words that are hard to spell
